Chief Bowen thanked the Committee for working with the City of Bridgeton regarding shared services. Chief Justice gave a brief summary of his years of service and to welcome any needs the Committee may have.

A motion was made (Shivers, Burton) to hire special Conflict Attorney Rick Coe Esq. for the Planning Board using the same rate as the Planning Board Solicitor for the December 19th meeting regarding Diamond Materials. (3-0)

A motion was made (Shivers, Burton) to introduce the State Storm Water Ordinances on first Reading. (3-0)

Mr. Burton said tree trimming were done on Geisinger, Serata and Cook. He also said that a new sign needs to be made for the Convenience Center explaining what can and cannot be brought for recycle, including refrigerators, propane tanks, etc.

Mr. Shivers mentioned having a property sale in the Spring. The Asst Clerk will ask the Tax Assessor of properties owned by the Township.

The Committee discussed getting the gates installed at the Convenience Center. They also discussed possibly hiring a local Housing Officer who would be able to attend planning board meetings for 2024.

The Treasurer submitted his report electronically. A motion made (Burton, Shivers) to pay the bills and adjourn the meeting. (3-0)
