Chief Mayhew said the budget for the fire dept will remain the same for 2025. He reported they responded to 73 calls so far mostly fires with total losses.

The Cap Ordinance for 2025 was introduced. A motion was made to accept the cap ordinance on 1st reading.

The budget was introduced. A motion was made to accept the budget on first reading.
