Mr. Burton said roadside trimming might be necessary soon on Columbia, Pony & Casper rds. He will check with the Treasurer to see what monies are available. A motion was made to (Burton, Levick) to trim the roadsides pending funds available from the Treasurer.

The Zoning/Housing officer reported ongoing corrections of violations.

The second Reading of the Fee Ordinance #2025-40 was introduced. A motion was made (Burton, Levick) to open the meeting up to the public for comment 3-0. No one spoke for or against the ordinance and a motion to close the public comment was made (Burton, Levick), 3-0. A motion was made to pass this Ordinance (Burton, Levick) 3-0.

A resolution supporting the Codification of ordinances was introduced (Burton, Levick). The cost would be @\$16,400.00 plus legal fees. It should be completed in 10 months. This resolution passed (3-0).

A resolution supporting the sale of Township Property to Gene Rarey was introduced (Burton, Levick). This Passed (3-0).

The Treasurer emailed the Treasurers report. A motion was made (Burton, Levick) to pay the bills and adjourn the meeting.
