Correspondence was read, no action taken.

Brittany Snyder spoke about the new laws going into affect regarding residential smoke inspections to obtain a C/O. Bridgeton FD is certified and will inspect for a fee. A check list will be put on the Stow Creek Website similar to that of the Bridgeton FD website.

Mr. Burton said the E waste building at the Convenience Center is full again, and is working with a county contractor to empty it for free. He also reported that raising the curb on Geisinger Road to avoid the runoff affecting a neighboring property would cost about \$3500.00. The resident affected said he would contribute \$1000.00 towards the cost.

Mr. Levick reported that Ambulance service for the Township may be increasing in cost for 2026. He also mentioned that the County may be considering offering the service in the future.

The Clerk reported the resurfacing bids for Cruzan Road were opened. A resolution was introduced (Levick, Burton) supporting the resurfacing awarded to South State for \$144,837.63. (3-0)

The Clerk then introduced a resolution supporting upcoming raffles for Woodland. A motion was made (Burton, Levick) to support this resolution. Another resolution was introduced supporting an upcoming Raffle for the Stow Creek Greenwich school.

The Treasurer submitted the Treasurers report, a motion was made (Burton, Levick) to pay the bills and adjourn the meeting.
