

Stow Creek Township Meeting December 10th , 2024

Present: Mayor Cruzan, Committeemen; Tom Burton, Chris Levick Asst Clerk; Bruce Porter, Clerk / Treasurer; Ron Campbell, Solicitor; Adam Telsey

Mayor Cruzan Lead the Flag salute.

Mr. Burton prayed for guidance and wisdom

Minutes approved (Burton, Cruzan) as sent out.

Correspondence was read, no action taken.

The Solicitor swore in Mr. Chris Levick to fill the remaining term for Dave Shivers.

The Mayor reported speaking to the State Police regarding a resident's rabid dog that had died in a vets care.

Mr. Burton reported that ewaste is going out this Friday. He also said the washout problem on Geisinger Ave would cost \$3200.00 to repair. The Committee opted to table the discussion until the new year.

The Clerk presented a transfer of funds resolution.

Snow removal to Buildings and grounds. A motion was made (Cruzan, Burton) to accept this resolution. (3-0)

The Clerk then presented a Fralinger Engineering proposal for the resurfacing of Cruzan Road for the sum of \$25,125.00. A motion was made (Burton, Cruzan) to accept this proposal (3-0).

The Clerk discussed with the Committee the Storm water Ordinance. He explained the process to comply so that the Engineer can create the maps reflecting drainage in the Township.

The Clerk presented a resolution supporting an upcoming Raffle, Bingo & 50/50 to be held at Woodland Day School on January 11th, 2025. A motion was made (Burton, Cruzan) to support this resolution. (3-0).

The Clerk presented the contract to repave Cook Road. A motion was made (Burton, Levick) to execute this contract. (3-0).

The Committee decided to have the yearend meeting December 30th, 2024, 6pm and the reorganization meeting January 7th, 2025 6pm at the Shiloh Hall.

The Solicitor suggested that the Township have a Code Book created reflecting all the rules and regulations in the Township. The costs would be around \$15,000.00 to \$25,000.00. The Solicitor offered to spearhead the project and report back to the committee with suggestions.

The Treasurer issued the Treasurers report.

A motion was made to pay the bills and adjourn.
